

**TO:** UBC Residents / Students

**RE: WHERE CAN I PARK WITH MY PARKING PASS??**

To better assist you with your health authority parking, we have outlined the site and corresponding valid area(s) where this pass is accepted. Please remember, parking is available on a limited basis and we ask that you park only in the designated areas outlined below.

**Staff Lots only:**

- **BH** - Small 15 stall lot 1503-A (across from Parkade entrance)
- **CGH** - Staff Surface Lots
- **ERH** - Staff Lots Only
- **LMH** - Staff Lots Only
- **PAH** - Main Public Lot "B" / Staff Lot "C"(across street 16/156)  
Not valid in "A" OR "D" Lot
- **QPCC** - Main Public/Staff Lot
- **RMH** - Staff Surface Lots
- **RCH** - Allen Street only
- **SMH** - North/South Parkade(s), 138<sup>th</sup> St Surface Lot.

**Program Specific Pink Parking Pass Restrictions**

Clearly display the valid pass within the valid parking areas only. Permits are valid within the staff lots at all FH facilities. Parking outside of authorized lot may result in irrevocable parking violations being issued at the permit holders' expense. Permits become void if altered in any way.

**How do I use my green temporary daily permit?** Note: Valid for 13 hours only.

- CLEARLY display your Daily Permit on your dash;
- Park in first available stall within Parkade or surface lot;
- **REMEMBER YOUR STALL NUMBER;** if applicable.
- Proceed to Parking Meter to Pay
- Input STALL NUMBER
- Scroll through menu (See more options) to find – STAFF DAILY RATE;
- Pay Daily Rate via **EXACT COIN** or CREDIT CARD – **Note:** Dispenser does not provide or give back CHANGE
- You're DONE!

No need to return to your vehicle to display receipt unless.....

**What if I leave during the day?**

Chances are you won't get the same stall you originally parked in when you return;

- Park in available stall with your Daily Permit CLEARLY displayed on your dash;
- YOU MUST DISPLAY YOUR RECEIPT ON THE DASH – This step provides proof of payment to the patroller;
- There is no need to purchase another ticket.
